



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Does everyone get to do this project?

YES. This is a state requirement for graduation for all students.

Do I need an Expert?

YES. A Field Expert is anyone who is an expert in the field in which you are doing your project. It has to be an adult (a teacher, a community member).

Do I have to write a Project Plan.

YES. A plan must be approved by the Senior Project Coordinator and your parents before you can begin your project.

How many sources do I need for my Bibliography?

Three different kinds or more are required, with one being a **Primary Resource**.

What is an MLA formatted Annotated Bibliography?

Annotated is a special type of bibliography. For this type of bibliography, you record all the resources you used while researching your topic and then add a comment to each entry summarizing the resource and evaluating how the resource was helpful to your research. The MLA format provides the guidelines to type the bibliography. Please see Senior Project web site for resources.

How long does my Presentation have to be?

Your Presentation must be at least 10 minutes in length, plus extra time to answer questions from your Panel.

Do I need a visual for my presentation?

NO. It is not mandatory that you use a visual during your presentation, but is encouraged. If using a visual it must support the project (pictures, video, the project, poster, slides, something you created...). Showing a video cannot replace your ten minute presentation.

What if I miss a deadline?

Deadlines help you complete the project on time. Keep in mind, the assignments that are due before the Presentation must be turned in before you are scheduled a time slot. If you are unable to meet any deadlines for serious reasons, please prearrange with Senior Project Coordinator.

How much time do I need to document?

Thirty (30) hours are required. Any time you spend on your project outside of class counts as long as it is documented. Write the date and time you're working on it as well as a short description in your Time Log.

Who do I go to for help?
