

Your 10 minute presentation + 10 minutes Q&A

The three important elements of your presentation are:

- Talk about the process you went through to create your final product
- Talk about what you learned
- Give specific examples or demonstrations

Here is an outline of what your presentation should look like:

1. Attention getter

A statement to get the audience's attention and get them focused on your presentation.

2. Self- introduction

3. Topic selection

What you did for your senior project?

Why you chose your topic?

What was the research you did to support your Project?

4. Research and process

Describe your final product

Describe the process you went through to create it

Give specific examples

A visual isn't mandatory, but may enhance your presentation.

Show pictures, video, the actual product...

5. What you learned

How can you apply what you learned?

What you thought went well

What you feel could be improved

6. Conclusion

Summarize your speech

Leave your audience with an overall great impression of you and your project

Remember: all previous assignments must be turned in before presenting

Dress requirement

Dressing appropriately for a professional presentation is expected. No jeans, athletic shoes or evening attire. The presentation is the major part of your Project you want to make a good impression.
